

# INSTRUCTIONS

## PRODUCTS WHICH REQUIRE REGISTRATION

Under Vermont Law all pesticides are defined as "Economic Poisons" and require state registration. An "Economic Poison" is defined as:

any substance produced, distributed or used for preventing, destroying or repelling any insects, rodents, nematodes, fungi, weeds, or other forms of plant or animal life or viruses, except viruses on or in living humans or other animals, which the Secretary shall declare to be a pest or any substance produced, distributed or used as a plant regulator, defoliant or desiccant.

Pesticide products are misbranded if they do not display an EPA Registration Number or a Vermont Registration Number. Pesticide products which are 25(b) federally exempt may apply for a Vermont Registration Number by writing or calling:

1. A copy of the federally registered label (actual product label not EPA approved label),
2. Labeling as required by the State of Vermont for registration of 25(b) federally exempt products, including a copy or statement of all claims that will be made for this product.
