

Vector Potential of Vermont Mosquitoes

Vector potential means that the mosquito is capable of carrying the disease if the disease is present in the host. Note that some of these diseases are not present in Vermont.

WNV	West Nile Virus	Reported in humans, horses, birds and mosquitoes
EEE	Eastern Equine Encephalitis	Reported in humans, horses, birds and mosquitoes
JC	Jamestown Canyon Encephalitis	Not reported in Vermont
SLE	St. Louis Encephalitis	Not reported in Vermont
LAC	Lacrosse Encephalitis Virus	Not reported in Vermont
MAL	Malaria	Reported in travelers outside state
DHW	Dog Heart Worm	Present, affects dogs
