Agriculture & Working Lands Assistance Application Eligibility

Eligibility Requirements for ALL Agriculture & Working Lands Applicants

To be eligible to apply for the Vermont COVID-19 Agriculture Assistance Program (VCAAP) Agriculture & Working Lands application, business applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- be domiciled or have a primary place of business in Vermont;
- be without an active enforcement violation that reached a final order with the Agency of Agriculture, Food & Markets (VAAFM) and/or the Agency of Natural Resources (ANR);
- be in compliance with all terms of any current grant agreement(s) or contract(s) with VAAFM and/or ANR;
- since March 1, 2020 have experienced expenses, lost revenue, or both relating to business interruption caused by COVID-19;
- not received funding from any other Vermont State COVID-19 recovery program[†]; and
- have a gross annual income of at least \$10,000 and perform activities eligible under this application.
