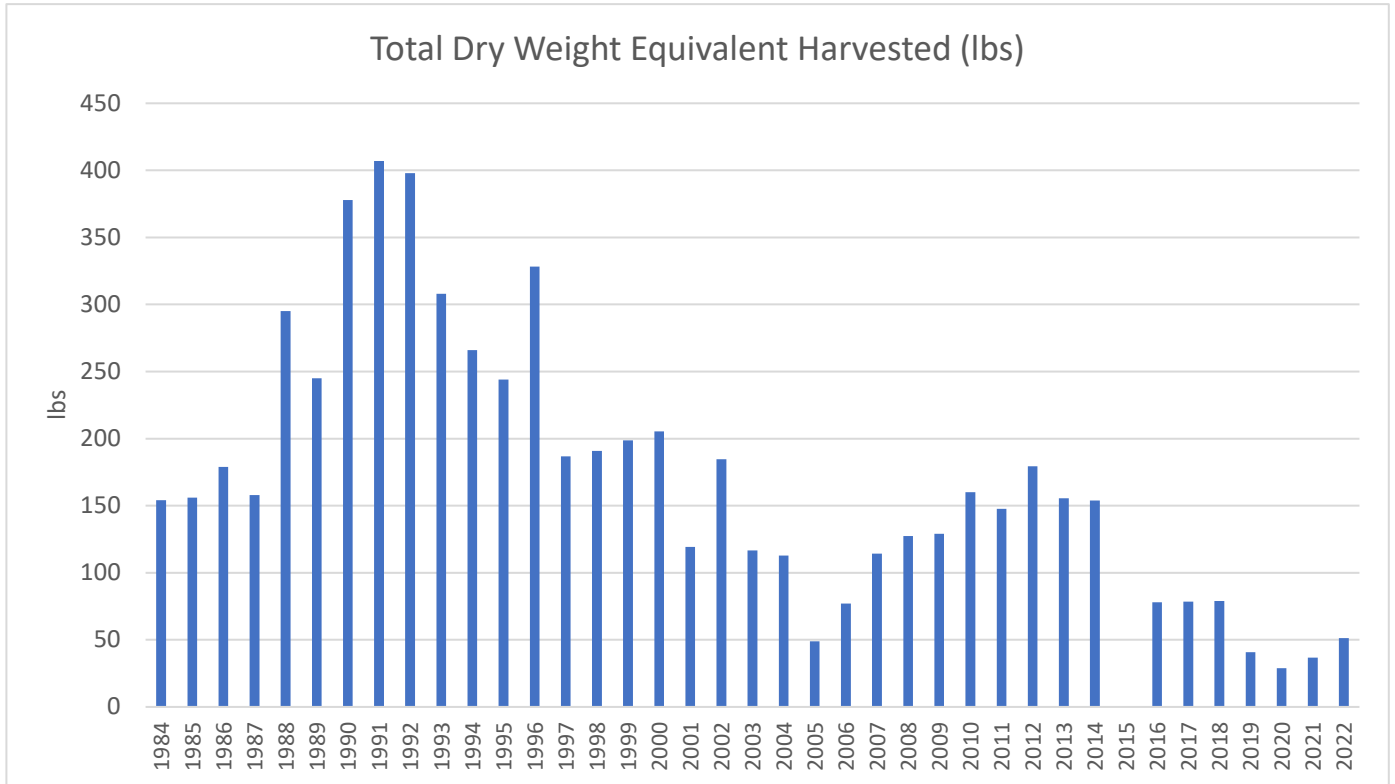


Figure 1. This graph shows the total weight of ginseng certified by the Vermont Agency of Agriculture, Food & Markets each year. Green root weight was converted to dry weight by dividing by 3; dry weight and converted green weight were added together to get total weight harvested. Data for 2015 was not available.

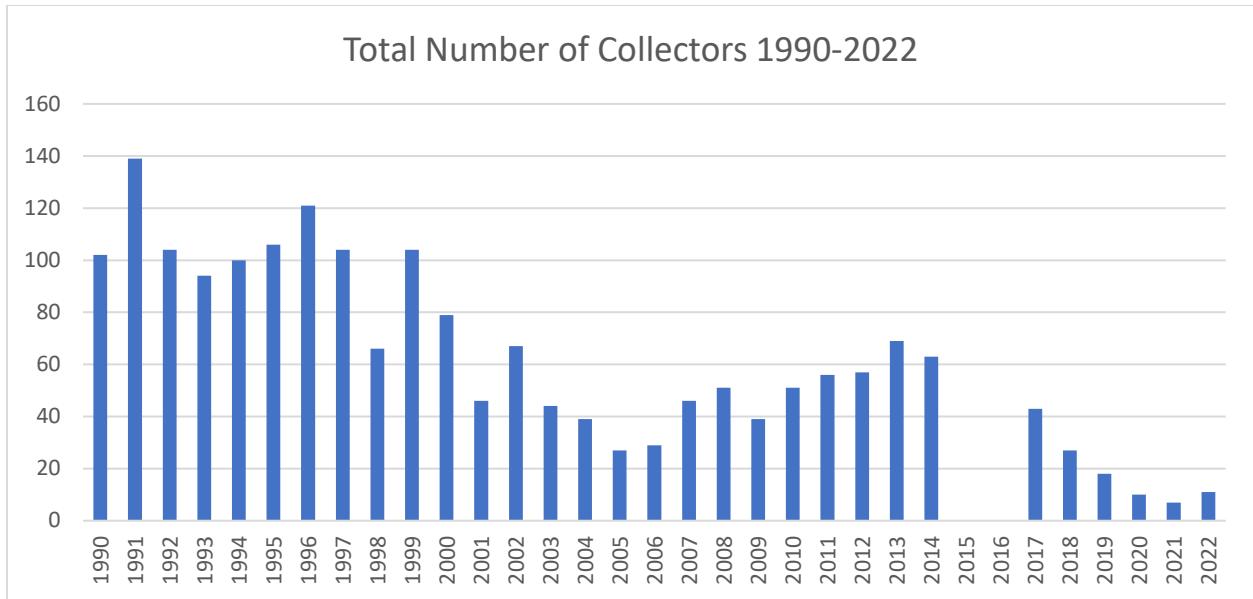


Figure 2. This graph shows the total number of collectors who sold to dealers combined with the number of Vermont dealers if they also collected in the state. Collectors who harvested for personal use or direct sales within Vermont are not included. Data from 2015 and 2016 was not available.

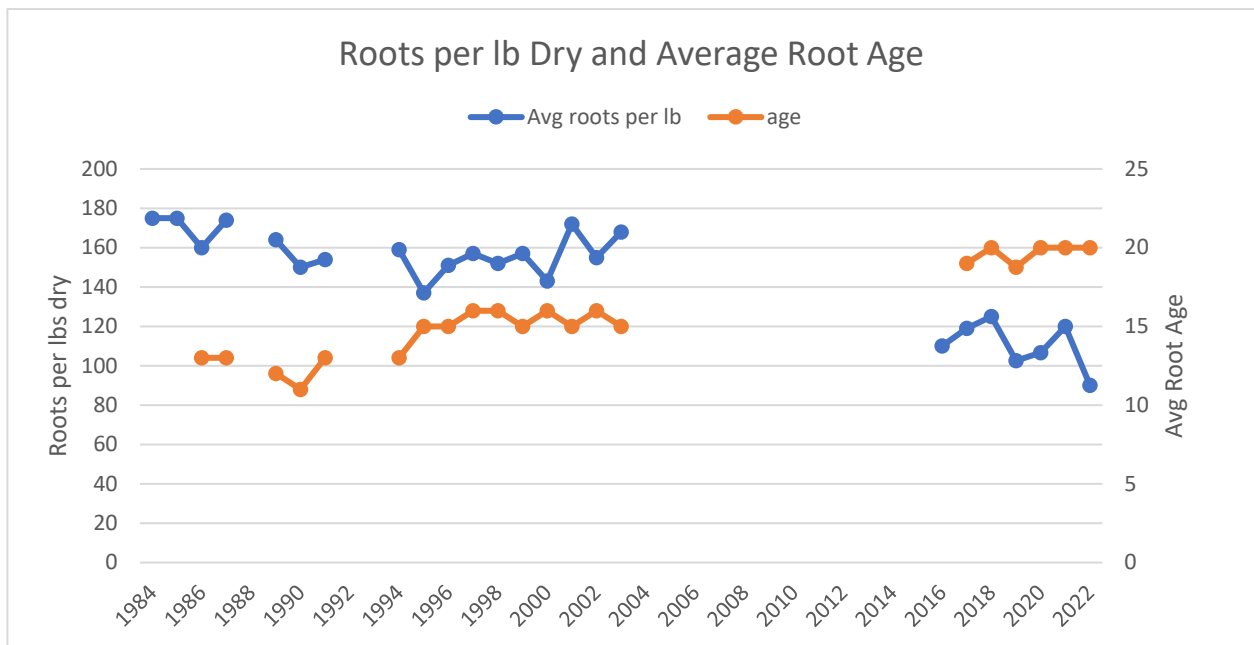


Figure 3. Combined graph showing average roots per pound (dry weight equivalent) and average rootage from 1984 to 2022. This data is derived from dealer purchase reports. There are some gaps in the data, most notably from 2004-2015.
