

Since 2006:

- 111 onsite mitigation areas, or 1,422 acres, have been protected via an Act 250 permit condition and have been mapped by the Agency.
- 1,311 acres of the total are primary agricultural soils:
 - 460 acres of prime soils
 - 830 acres of state wide soils
 - 21 acres of locally important soils
 - 111 acres are unrated soils
- (about) 590 acres of primary agricultural soils have been impacted.
